<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: President Miller called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

CEREMONIAL MATTERS AND/OR TOPIC FOR PRIORITY CONSIDERATION

Recognizing the Members of the West Windsor Volunteer Fire Company; the Princeton Junction Volunteer Fire Company; and the Township of West Windsor Fire and Emergency Services Division.

Mayor Marathe announced that it is Fire Prevention month and that he along with the members of the Township Council want to recognize the two volunteer fire companies and the Division of Fire and Emergency Services this evening.

Mayor Marathe read the proclamation that was presented to Chief Carmine Cirillo of the West Windsor Volunteer Fire Company and Chief David Terzian of the Princeton Junction Volunteer Fire Company for their outstanding service to the residents of West Windsor Township for over ninety (90) years.

Council President Miller read the proclamation for the members of the Township's Division of Fire and Emergency Services thanking them for their service to the Community.

James Yates, Manager of the Division of Fire and Emergency

Services, thanked Council members and the Mayor on behalf of his
staff and recognized Firefighter Doug Frueh for his continued
efforts in the area of Fire Prevention.

Members of Council thanked everyone for their dedicated service to the Community.

PUBLIC COMMENT

- Ms. Claire Huang, Ms. Cassie Wang, and Ms. Alisa Zihai Xiao all members of the AYLUS at West Windsor Plainsboro High School South, noted their support for the single use plastic bag ban before Council this evening. They presented several reasons why there is a need for reducing plastic from our waste stream.
- Ms. Jackie Ayers, 41 O'Neill Court, Lawrenceville, inquired about Resolution 2019-R224 and whether there would be additional Change Orders required for this project.
- Mr. Ethan Bruzzese, 4 Babbit Way, Allentown, inquired about Ordinance 2019-33 and if additional funding will be required to complete the project.
- Mr. John Hinsdale, 38 Quaker Road, provided his opinion on the use of social media by the Mayor and Council members. He noted that there are political statements being made on the Township's Facebook and that he feels this is not proper.
- Ms. Tirza Wahrman, 5 Stonelea Drive, noted her support for the single use plastic bag ban and that there is a phasing-in period for area businesses to comply. She noted that a letter was sent to the Clerk providing additional information. Ms. Wahrman suggested that everyone use reusable bags.
- Mr. Paul Pitluk, 69 Rainflower Lane, congratulated Council on the passing of Resolution 2019-R220a and noted that the timing is appropriate. He read the resolution into the record.

- Ms. Corinna Bisgaier, 7 Villa Drive, spoke in favor of the plastic bag ban and noted it is a really easy fix for a big problem. She noted that the stores should begin to use bioplastic bags.
- Ms. Jennifer Coffey, ANJEC Representative, advised that her group is a non-profit that works with residents and municipalities on environmental matters. She provided some statistics on plastic bag bans throughout New Jersey and noted over 89 municipalities have instituted some type of ban on plastic bags, styrofoam containers, and plastic straws to name a few. Ms. Coffey noted that by local municipalities passing these type of ordinances her organization is hopeful that the New Jersey Legislature will get on board.
- Mr. Sanjev Rajaram, 5 Rushton Court, noted that he disagrees with Council on the passing of Resolution 2019-R220a on gun control. He encouraged everyone to exercise their Second Amendment right and to go out and get a fire arms permit.
- Ms. Sonia Gawas, 28 Melville Road, noted her support for Resolution 2019-R223 for "No Parking" in front of Maurice Hawk School on Clarksville Road during school hours.
- $\underline{\text{Mr. DJ Varner, 13 Amherst Way,}}$ noted his support for the plastic bag ban. He advised that we should support the students who are working very hard on this matter.
- Ms. Andrea Mandel, 46 Ellsworth Drive, voiced her concerns about the intersection of North Post Road and Clarksville Road and encouraged the Township to have the County do a study of this intersection. She also suggested getting residents input and having the Township provide regular updates on the matter.
- Ms. Randi Kronthel-Sacco, 22 Wynwood Drive, noted her support of the plastic bag ban and urged Council members to be in the forefront of this problem.
- Mr. John Church, 11 Princeton Place, noted that in his opinion these bags are not single use bags. He advised that he is concerned about the cost for implementing this ordinance and the cost for staff to enforce.

Mr. Jeff Onuhskook, 1721 Old Trenton Road, inquired about the parcel being purchased on Clarksville Road and what it will be used for.

ADMINISTRATION COMMENTS

Ms. Schmid advised of the following:

- Public Works is in Zone 2 for brush and leaf pickup
- Reminder that the Alexander Road Bridge closure will begin on November 6, 2019 and that the project is expected to take 6 months to complete
- Reminded everyone to sign-up for Nixel alerts to stay informed

Mayor Marathe announced that the Township has received the 2019 Green Communities award and thanked both Mr. Dobromilsky and the Shade Tree Commission for their efforts. He noted that he attended the Township's Fire Prevention event on Sunday, October 6th which was held at West Windsor-Plainsboro South campus and encouraged everyone to attend this event in the future. Mayor Marathe suggested that a special Council meeting be held to talk about environmental problems facing the Township.

COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS

Mr. Zhang thanked everyone for their support of the proposed plastic bag ban ordinance. He also thanked Ms. Coffey of ANJEC and the high school students for attending the meeting this evening. Mr. Zhang also thanked Mr. Church for bringing a different perspective to the problem.

Ms. Manzari again provided her concerns on the Mr. Hinsdale's web-site. She noted that she attended the Township's Fire Prevention event and that there was a lot of good information provided and encouraged everyone to attend next year. Ms. Manzari advised that she also attended the Pancake Breakfast held by the Princeton Junction Volunteer Fire Company this past Sunday. She announced the Township's Trunk or Treat will be held on Saturday, October 26th starting at 3:00 p.m. at Duck Pond Park.

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Ms. Hamilton thanked Mayor Marathe for bringing up recycling of plastic bottles. She noted her support for the plastic bag ban and noted it will help in the reduction of recycling costs going forward.

Ms. Geevers reported that she attended the Princeton Junction Volunteer Fire Company Pancake Breakfast and that it was a wonderful community event. She advised that personally she is in favor of a plastic bag ban but noted her concerns with the process that has taken place. Ms. Geevers noted that she has concerns with not notifying the stakeholders and that a meeting should be scheduled with area businesses to receive their input on the matter.

CHAIR/CLERK COMMENTS

President Miller announced that the Historical Society of West Windsor has a new web-site and encouraged residents to go out and view it. She noted that Ms. Mandel is right about the intersection of North Post Road and Clarksville Road needing to be improved and inquired about the results of the study for the intersection of Village Road, West, Penn Lyle Road, and Baxter Place. President Miller advised that she also attended the Pancake Breakfast at the firehouse and that she had a good time. She advised that it is time for the Township Council to act on the plastic bag ban ordinance and that the Administration can figure out how to enforce it once it's been approved.

2019-34 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 148 SOLID WASTE ADDING ARTICLE IV SINGLE-USE PLASTIC BAG REDUCTION OF THE CODE OF WEST WINDSOR TOWNSHIP

Ms. Manzari advised that she is all for saving the environment, however she feels that the process for this ordinance was not done in a transparent way and that there is a need to reach out to area businesses to get their feedback on how this will affect them. She advised that Administration needs to be involved as well in this process. Ms. Manzari noted that it is Council's job to figure out all the problems before moving this forward. She also noted her concerns with the financial implications this could cause the Township.

Ms. Geevers advised that normally such an ordinance would have come before Council to discuss and then move it forward for introduction once all of their questions and concerns were addressed.

Mayor Marathe advised that the ordinance has not been discussed at the Council level enough and that in the Township Attorney's opinion it is not legal for the Township to set a charge for a bag fee.

Mr. Herbert advised that he has to sign to form and legality of each ordinance and that currently he can only sign to form as

being correct for this ordinance. He noted that there are three things constitutionally he is concerned about: the commerce clause; permitted by federal and state law clause; and the setting of a fee for use of a plastic bag clause.

Ms. Hamilton inquired if Section 148-28 and 148-33 were removed would that help.

Mr. Herbert advised he still couldn't sign as to legality.

Mayor Marathe said that legal costs for this ordinance could range between \$15,000.00 and \$30,000.00 if someone challenges the ordinance.

Mr. Zhang advised that this ordinance is universal and we don't need to make it fit to West Windsor. He noted that the group has reached out to area businesses and their feedback was presented to Council.

President Miller advised that there is time in the next two weeks to get questions answered regarding the ordinance.

Mayor Marathe expressed his concerns on how this will affect the business community.

Mr. Zhang advised that this is the trend and will send a great message to new businesses.

ADDITIONAL PUBLIC COMMENT

- Mr. John Church, 11 Princeton Place, advised that this is one of the lowest points in Council history. He noted that he has never seen an ordinance introduced that the Township Attorney does not support. Mr. Church voiced his concerns that this is not a good idea to pass this ordinance without Attorney support.
- Ms. Jennifer Coffey, ANJEC Representative, thanked everyone for their support and offer to share information with Mr. Herbert on his concerns. She advised that the New Jersey Legislature passed a bill last year, and her organization asked the Governor not to sign because it didn't go far enough.
- Ms. Tirza Wahrman, 5 Stonelea Drive, advised that she started researching this in 2018 and starting working with ANJEC. She noted that area businesses were reached out to and have been receptive to the idea. Ms. Wahrman expressed her opinion that this is legal to do.
- Ms. Sonia Gawas, 28 Melville Road, noted that the process should be followed and that government should not work this way.
- Mr. Alex Cobbs, 116 Hickory Corner Road, East Windsor, inquired about the ordinance and who will pay for the reusable bags. He suggested that fines be reduced for smaller businesses.
- Ms. Shin-Yi Lin, 8 Harrison Lane, wanted to clarify that she drafted the information sheets for both residents and businesses to be used once the ordinance was adopted.

COUNCIL REPORTS/DISCUSSION TOPICS/NEW BUSINESS

- Ms. Geevers advised that the Planning Board approved a minor subdivision at their October 2, 2019 meeting. She announced that the "Celebrations" application hearing will be continued at the November 7, 2019 Zoning Board of Adjustment meeting.
- Mr. Zhang advised that he attended the Environmental Commission meeting and that discussion occurred about the plastic bag ban. He noted that the application for Sustainable New Jersey has been submitted.

President Miller advised that at the Affordable Housing Committee meeting they discussed two proposals: the first for the Bear Creek Assisted Living Development and the second was the Hilton Garden Development across from the Elements on Old Trenton Road. President Miller noted that the Affordable Housing Committee has written a memorandum to the staff/professionals on the Committees concerns for future development.
