Ms. Huber led the salute to the flag.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. John Hinsdale, 38 Quaker Road, spoke about first amendment rights and that the call for Ms. Hamilton's resignation at the last Council meeting was out of line.

Ms. Melissa Nagy, President of the West Windsor PBA 271, advised that members of the PBA were present at the meeting of March 18th in support of their K-9 Officer. She reviewed the events of the previous meeting and comments that have been made on social media sites.

Ms. Hamilton thanked Ms. Nagy for her comments and noted it is her job to question items before Council. She advised that she welcomes Ms. Nagy back to speak in the future.

Mr. Frank Bal, Member of the West Windsor PBA 271, clarified the remarks made by Ms. Nagy.

President Miller advised that everyone has the right to speak in this forum.

Ms. Kathy Gu, 69 Southfield Road, spoke about safety issues along Southfield Road and requested that the Township look into ways to make this area safer. She suggested reducing the speed limit, curve ahead signs be posted, and speed bumps be

installed. Ms. Gu also requested pedestrian crosswalk signage be installed.

Mayor Marathe advised he will have the appropriate staff members review this matter.

Mr. Constantine Kardaras, 31 Ketley Place #6, requested that the 30 year affordable housing designation be made optional for Windsor Haven units.

Mr. Muller addressed Mr. Kardaras' concerns.

Mr. Andy Bromberg, 24 Providence Drive, advised that he watched the April 1st meeting and was shocked at what he heard. He advised that it is the Council's job to watch the spending. Mr. Bromberg noted he supports the police, and noted that this matter should be discussed privately.

Mr. John Church, 11 Princeton Place, provided his views on Resolution 2019-R089 before Council regarding the Affordable Housing Trust Fund. He suggested changing the word "may" to "shall".

Mr. Muller provided an explanation to Council on the necessity of this ordinance. He advised that this resolution is for rehabilitation of affordable housing units.

Ms. Veronica Mehno, 41 Galston Drive, voiced her concerns about public comment made at the April 1, 2019 Council meeting regarding Ms. Hamilton.

ADMINISTRATION COMMENTS

Mayor Marathe noted that he has spoken to both Councilperson Hamilton and Ms. Nagy about this matter. He advised that everyone has the right to speak under the first amendment.

Ms. Schmid announced that Mercer County has reopened the Alexander Road Bridge this evening. She also noted that Public Works Department is in Zone 3 for brush pick-up.

Mayor Marathe thanked everyone for their assistance during the funeral held at Beth Chaim Synagogue for the young lady from

Robbinsville who was killed in South Carolina. He announced that the lottery for the Project Freedom Development will take place on Wednesday, April $24^{\rm th}$ at the Municipal Building in Room A starting at 9:00 a.m.

COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS

Mr. Zhang noted he was happy to see Ms. Gu come to the meeting and express her concerns about Southfield Road. He advised that flooding occurred on Penn Lyle Road between 113 and 143. Mr. Zhang spoke about the contributions made by the Chinese immigrants on the construction of the Transcontinental Railroad. He suggested that the two parties (Ms. Nagy and Councilperson Hamilton) meet to resolve their differences.

Ms. Manzari advised that everyone has first amendment rights. She noted that all members of Council during the budget process asked questions and that all members voted to delay the vote on the K-9 payment until Council had more information, not just one member of Council. Ms. Manzari also noted that when the K-9 approval came back to Council everyone voted in favor of it. She reminded everyone to pull over for emergency vehicles.

Ms. Hamilton thanked Mr. Zhang for his comments. She announced that she will not be running for election.

Ms. Geevers noted that Council Members and Mayor Marathe worked very hard on the 2019 budget and that everyone asked questions about the budget. She sent her condolences to the family of Lynn Thornton who was the Senior Center Director for many years and recently passed away. Ms. Geevers requested that Mr. Guzik, the Township Engineer look into the Southfield Road issues. She requested that something be placed on the Township web-site regarding measles and she wished everyone a Happy Easter and Passover.

CHAIR/CLERK COMMENTS

President Miller advised she remembers Ms. Thornton and noted that West Windsor is a wonderful place and we should all try to get along. She advised that the Friends of West Windsor Open Space cleaned up 250 pounds of garbage along Clarksville Road. She thanked all who came out and helped.
