Good morning Gay – below are comments for the record for the meeting tonight. I will be on the call attending the meeting. Thanks and please let me know if you have any questions.

Good evening, my name is Richard Kenwood, and I am the Vice President & General Manager of MarketFair. I would like to express our strong interest in adoption of the ordinance amendment amending the B-2 District Standards.

I would also like to express our gratitude to the Township for expanding the category of permitted uses in the B-2 District and allowing for taller buildings in a planned commercial development along Route 1. That said, we are under the opinion that there was an opportunity that this ordinance should have also increased the MIC from 60% to 65%, and this sentiment was voiced at the Planning Board meeting of July 8, 2020.

The opinion given was this would be a material change, thus would have to go back to Township Council for comment and recommendation. MarketFair respectfully requests that the Township Council consider incorporating this request into the Amended Zoning Ordinance.

MarketFair appreciates the municipality updating its zoning ordinance to meet current market demand. Thank you for your time.

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My name is Elizabeth Greber, and I reside at 132 Cranbury Road. I am a life long resident of Cranbury Road. I am the Executor of 5 properties on Cranbury Road, including Wildflowers Farm which encompasses 315 and 433 Cranbury Road, which are on both sides of the tract in question. I am here once again to address concerns I have over the usage of the property we have leased for agricultural use from PSEG since October, 1993. Prior to our lease it was leased to the Shelke family (the previous farm owners).

Since the trolley line was removed, the tract has been leased for farm use, for over 100 years.

I addressed this Council years ago when it was proposed to put a bike path through our farm. When I last addressed Council I outlined this histor and, the dangers in putting a path through the farm. It was agreed by Council that it would be dangerous to people and livestock on the farm, but also to people on the path. Furthermore, Council agreed that paths would not go *through* anyone's property in West Windsor.

And once again, I find myself before you. PSEG will not repair the trestle. They will not build a bridge. Either project would be a multimillion dollar project. And moreover, it is a liability issue they do not want, nor would I think the township would want. So if you to pave through the farm, it will be to a dead end, what is the point?

We have pastures on both sides of the farmed right of way. Horses, people-including children, walk leading horses back and forth, mowing, above ground water hoses and at times electrical cords; farm equipment is operated and parked on the tract. Outside professionals, including the ferriers, vet and saddle adjusters work in close proximity of the tract. Distractions to the horses would endanger these professionals. Outsiders traversing the property are a threat to these operations and these operations can be a threat to the passerby. We have had people over the years try to feed our animals, not knowing the proper way to do so makes the loss of fingers a possibility. Or the animal could be restricted from eating, say a carrot because they are on a soft diet and could choke to

death. Will the town be responsible when a child loses a finger or for the cost of the horse or needed treatment? I would think the mere thought of Council's decision being responsible for the possible harm to a person or animal would be enough to stop this project where it ends now, at Rabbit Hill Road. We have our property posted and even so we must ask trespassers to leave, at least on a weekly basis.

Would any of you or your children know what to do if a 1200 pound horse breaks out of a pasture and is cantering the farm? Do you want your child in a riding lesson as people are biking by and yelling? How would you keep people from wandering from the path exploring the property?

PSEG understands the dangers and have worked with us on notice, timing and education of their workers when they come through for tree cutting and maintenance. They had a gate up with no trespassing notices. They intended to replace the gate. Until the paving issue arose once again.

I am unsure how the proposed paving got back on your agenda. We are the lease holders of the agricultural property in question. I would just add that we cannot operate a farm with unknown people coming through the property, we are not a park, we are not open space. Do any of you want people wandering through your backyard, taking a swing on your kid's playset, a dip in your pool? We do not want to violate the agricultural lease we have on the tract. A bike path is not an agricultural activity. If the paving through the farm takes place, our family feels we will no longer be able to operate the farm safely. Do you want another housing development? I would hate the community to lose a great asset and family that has been in this area since 1680. Our hard work, values, service, and ideals have helped shape this area into one which is desirable. We are saddened that our rights and privacy are being trampled on.
