Ms. Huber led the salute to the flag.

CEREMONIAL MATTERS AND/OR TOPIC FOR PRIORITY CONSIDERATION

Swearing in of Dr. Hemant Marathe as Mayor

Clerk Huber swore in Dr. Hemant Marathe as Mayor for his second term with his wife and mother by his side.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. Paul Ligeti, Vice President of the Historical Society of West Windsor, announced that the Historical Society has a whole years' worth of events scheduled for the 225th Anniversary Celebration of the Township and encouraged residents to visit their web-site for details.

<u>Ms. Tirza Wahrman, 5 Stonelea Drive</u>, congratulated Mayor Marathe and noted she wanted to follow-up on comments made at the last Council meeting by Brian Hughes, County Executive regarding the former Howard Hughes site.

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Mr. John Church, 11 Princeton Place, congratulated the Mayor and looks forward to working with him.

Mr. John Hinsdale, 38 Quaker Road, read excerpts from Martin Luther King Jr.'s speech into the record. He also noted his concerns with Resolution 2022-R034 on the agenda for action this evening.

ADMINISTRATION COMMENTS

Ms. Schmid advised that the Department of Public Works is currently collecting leaves in Zone 4 and will be working on brush through all zones starting on January 19th. She reported that there is still one week left for Christmas tree pick-up and reminded residents that they could also drop their trees at the Public Works Site Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and on Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to Noon. Ms. Schmid announced that the next vaccination clinic is scheduled for Tuesday, January 25th at the West Windsor Senior Center between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. She urged residents to schedule appointments through the Township web-site.

Mayor Marathe thanked everyone who came out today and for everyone who reached out with their concerns with his testing positive for COVID. He thanked everyone who helped him during his past four (4) years, especially the past three Council Presidents Alison Miller, Virginia Manzari, and Andrea Mandel. Mayor Marathe noted he is looking forward to attending many of the 225th Anniversary Celebration events being held this year. He advised in response to two (2) comments made this evening he has reached out to the County and they have their own process with regard to the development of the old Howard Hughes tract and are working with the developer as well as Township staff on the project. Mayor Marathe noted that he hopes to have all these meetings taped for rebroadcast when the time comes. He advised with regard to Resolution 2022-R034 Council Member Mandel has worked very hard on this and that all municipalities that are affected by this flooding both upstream and downstream need to work together with the State to take a regional approach to this matter.

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COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS

Ms. Mandel congratulated the Mayor on his second term. She noted she attended a joint religious zoom event over the weekend with regard to the recent hostage situation and thanked the West Windsor Police for their diligence in protecting the Township's religious facilities. Ms. Mandel thanked the Historical Society of West Windsor for all their hard work so far on the 225th Anniversary Celebration events. She thanked everyone who came out for Martin Luther King Jr. Day of Service to include Shupe, West Windsor Arts Council and the West Windsor Human Relations Council. Ms. Mandel noted that Resolution 2022-R034 is seeking a regional approach from other municipalities on the flooding issues we are all experiencing. She provided many reasons why this resolution is needed and why the Council is seeking others to join in solving this regional problem.

Mr. Stevens advised that President Gawas and he met with representatives of New Jersey Transit with regard to the current survey being conducted. He noted that this survey is needed so that they can receive federal funding and that New Jersey Transit is not looking to do any condemnation or taking of easements for their proposals. Mr. Stevens advised that there was a house fire on Millstone Road recently and that both volunteer fire companies along with Fire and Emergency Services personnel and the police responded. He thanked the mutual aid companies that responded as well as Public Works who had to be called out due to icing conditions. Mr. Stevens noted that West Windsor Police are requesting video from residents in the areas where break-ins have recently happened. He noted that on tonight's agenda the Municipal Judge is being reappointed and the Township is adopting the Hazardous Mitigation Plan which will provide grant opportunities for the Township pre and post disasters.

Ms. Geevers congratulated the Mayor on his next four (4) years and thanked everyone who was involved in the Martin Luther King Jr. Day events sponsored by the Human Relations Council. She noted that the flooding in our area especially on Washington Road is not just our issue but our upstream neighbors as well. Ms. Geevers thanked Ms. Mandel and Mr. Guzik for working on the resolution. She reminded residents to get your COVID vaccines and thanked the Historical Society of West Windsor for all the

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events they have planned for the Township's 225 Anniversary Celebration.

Mr. Whitfield congratulated the Mayor and thanked the West Windsor Historical Society. He noted that over 2,000 items were donated over the weekend as part of Martin Luther King Jr. Day and thanked the Human Relations Council on their video and all the other events they coordinated for the weekend.

CHAIR/CLERK COMMENTS

President Gawas thanked Ms. Mandel on taking the lead for the Millstone River resolution and advised this is a regional issue and needs to have everyone involved to resolve. She advised she attended the virtual lecture on West Windsor and the American Revolution (Ten Crucial Days) and noted she looks forward to attending more lectures. President Gawas announced the Historical Society of West Windsor is this year's West Windsor Gives Back sponsored organization. She noted the Historical Society has 225th Anniversary merchandise for sell on their website. President Gawas thanked the community for their generosity for the collection of food items over the weekend as part of the Martin Luther King Jr. Day Celebration.

Mayor Marathe announced that on January 2nd the Township staff lost one of their own Ruth Hall who was the receptionist for many years after a brief illness. He requested a moment of silence.
