<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: President Gawas called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

SALUTE TO THE FLAG

Ms. Huber led the salute to the flag.

<u>Moment of Silence</u> in remembrance of former West Windsor Mayor and Committee Member Gene O'Brien, a longtime resident and current Chairman of the West Windsor Planning Board.

Mayor Marathe noted Mr. O'Brien always put the Township first. He sends his condolences to the O'Brien family.

Mr. Stevens noted Mr. O'Brien was instrumental in the Mid-Atlantic Robotics Program and expanded it to include New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Delaware. He reported donations can be made to the robotics program which information can be found on the Township web-site.

Mr. Whitfield noted Mr. O'Brien has left an incredible mark on West Windsor. He advised everyone should learn to respect others opinions.

Ms. Mandel noted she attended Mr. O'Brien's service today and noted his years of service to the community and she will remember all the wonderful memories of him. She advised Mr. O'Brien heard all sides and served with honesty and integrity.

Ms. Geevers advised she attended Mr. O'Brien's funeral Mass at St. David the King today. She noted Mr. O'Brien served on the Township Committee, held the role of Mayor, served on the Planning Board during that time. Ms. Geevers advised he was a strong community leader and a mentor to many.

President Gawas advised she met Mr. O'Brien while attending Planning Board Meetings years ago. She noted he always listened to everyone; dedicated and loved West Windsor; was a former Mayor, Committee member and wore many other hats throughout his years. President Gawas advised she will miss his bow ties.

CEREMONIAL MATTERS AND/OR TOPICS FOR PRIORITY CONSIDERATION

Discussion on Ellsworth Redevelopment Center - Release of Restrictive Covenants; Right of Way Acceptance of Public Streets for Parkland/Open Space Access; Stormwater Utility Easement

Mr. Ed Schmierer, Zoning Board of Adjustment Attorney reviewed the history of the Ellsworth Redevelopment Center which started back in 2009. He advised there are three actions needing to occur for this project:

- 1. Release of covenants restriction on Cranbury Road
- 2.50 foot Right of Way needed per New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection to parkland owned by the Township, State and Mercer County
- 3. Stormwater needs 10 foot wide easements

Discussion ensued with members of Council raising questions/concerns that Mr. Schmierer addressed.

Discussion of Draft R-20 District FAR

Mr. Schmierer gave an overview of zoning applications that came before the Zoning Board of Adjustment for variances to increase the FAR of residential lots. He noted residents are losing time for modest improvements to their homes and the Zoning Board of Adjustment in their yearly report suggested the FAR be increased to 15% from 13%.

Discussion occurred among Council members and Mr. Schmierer regarding the need for this increase. Council asked to know the exact number of variances granted over the past couple of years before moving forward with this ordinance.

Draft Cluster Ordinance

Mayor Marathe reviewed the proposed changes with Council regarding this ordinance. He noted it does not change the density of the space.

Discussion occurred among members of Council and the Mayor with several questions/concerns being asked and addressed by the Mayor. Council had a number of concerns that the Clerk will get answers to and provide to Council prior to the Cluster ordinance coming before Council.

Draft EV (Electric Vehicle) Ordinance

Ms. Mandel noted one common problem with this type of ordinance is signage and advised she would like to see consistent signage throughout the township which also address the fines and penalties.

Ms. Geevers suggested signage be designed similar to handicap parking signs.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Mr. Bob Murray, 28 York Road, Pennington, my heart will always be in this town and I served on a lot of communities throughout the Township. He noted he sent Council and the Mayor a letter recently and asked if they had any questions with regard to his e-mail.

Ms. Alison Miller, 41 Windsor Drive, provided her comments on the draft cluster ordinance and noted her support for the EV (Electric Vehicle) ordinance. She did inquire how this effects required parking spaces.

Ms. Latha Keshalegin, 9 Candlewood Drive, noted her concerns with the increase in truck traffic with the proposed warehouses on Clarksville Road.

Mr. Ajay Kaisth, 20 Haskel Drive, noted his concerns with the warehouses and noted he is concerned about conflicts of interest among elected officials. He advised he is concerned about property values and noted the presentation provided by the applicant was not complete.

- Ms. Kristin Appelget, Vice President Princeton University, asked for direction as to whom on staff she should contact with regard to the EV (electric vehicle) ordinance and signage for their development on Washington Road.
- Ms. Tirza Wahrman, 5 Stonelea Drive, noted she is worried about the Bridgepoint 8 construction project. She also advised she was told the County was interested in purchasing this as open space in January of this year and contacted the Township regarding same.
- Mr. Khurram Waheed, 286 Clarksville Road, advised in his opinion the Mayor has a conflict of interest because he has a business in a warehouse in another part of the state. He noted the Planning Board Vice Chair Michael Karp should have respect for the public.
- Mr. Martin Hughes, 24 Benford Drive, advised he understands the bridge on Clarksville Road is under State control and inquired if the Township is aware of plans to replace.
- Ms. Stacey Fox, 29 Berrien Avenue, noted her concerns regarding child safety and inquired if the new guidelines from the State will be used for this warehouse application. She inquired when the "Climate resiliency" portion of the Master Plan will be updated.
- Mr. Ben Finkelstein, 43 Arnold Drive, noted he met the Mayor last Community Day and asked about warehouses and noted his concerns about the Mayor being not open.
- Mr. Shivesh Kmar, 31 Westwinds Drive, inquired what the end game is for this development.
- Ms. Arpitary Roy, 23 Quaker Road, noted public comment was limited to one meeting regarding the Bridgepoint 8 application which she feels is unfair to the residents. She suggested having one meeting a month be held for the public to engage with the elected officials.
- Ms. Shurthi Jayaraman, 10 Bolfmar Drive, noted the successful walk/bike campaign held over the weekend to stop the trucks. She inquired if information could be posted on the Township web-site regarding the impacts of this proposed development.

Mr. Sudarshan Sampath, 11 Barrington Drive, thanked the Township Council and Planning Board for their service to the community. He noted you have heard the residents need to use every tool in the toolbox to ensure safety measures are put in place.

Ms. Alexandra Humner, 31 Arnold Drive, inquired why SPRAB was discontinued.

Mr. John Hinsdale, 38 Quaker Road, complained about elected officials using private Facebook groups to disseminate information.

Ms. Gautham Kamath, 14 Shadow Drive, acknowledged the passing of Mr. O'Brien and inquired why traffic studies are not extended throughout the township.

ADMINISTRATION COMMENTS

Ms. Schmid made the following announcements:

Public Works in Zone 4 for yard waste. Reminder Public Works does not pick-up grass clippings.

Waste Management has notified the Township of manpower issues and garbage delays are expected. Visit the Township web-site for complete details.

COVID 19 Clinic scheduled for June $29^{\rm th}$ at the West Windsor Plainsboro Board of Education Building. See Township web-site for details.

July 4^{th} all municipal offices will be closed; trash pickup for Monday will be only on Thursday 7/7; Public Works will be closed on Saturday, July 2^{nd} .

Edinburg/Old Trenton Road Project has started. Will take approximately six weeks weather permitting to complete.

Reminder of Seasonal Property Maintenance Guidelines posted on the Township web-site for residents.

Mayor Marathe advised the Township has received three completed easement agreements for the Cranbury Road Sidewalk project and is awaiting two additional agreements to be signed. He reminded everyone Atlantic Realty owns the property where the warehouses are proposed. Mayor Marathe noted the election campaign was all

about warehouses versus no warehouses. He advised SPRAB was eliminated because it was like a mini Planning Board and most towns have a Technical Review Committee made up of staff and township professionals. Mayor Marathe noted this property was never on the Township's Open Space list and he advised the County and the State they could buy it for open space. He advised several elements of the master plan still need to be heard by the Planning Board. Mayor Marathe reported the bridge on Clarksville Road will be replaced by the State in the future. He advised he has been speaking to other Townships to see how they worked with the State to get restrictions such as weight limit restrictions on roadways.

Mr. Stevens wished everyone a happy 4th of July. He reminded residents of the upcoming Historical Society events to celebrate the Township's 225th Anniversary and advised everyone to continue to remember Ukraine.
